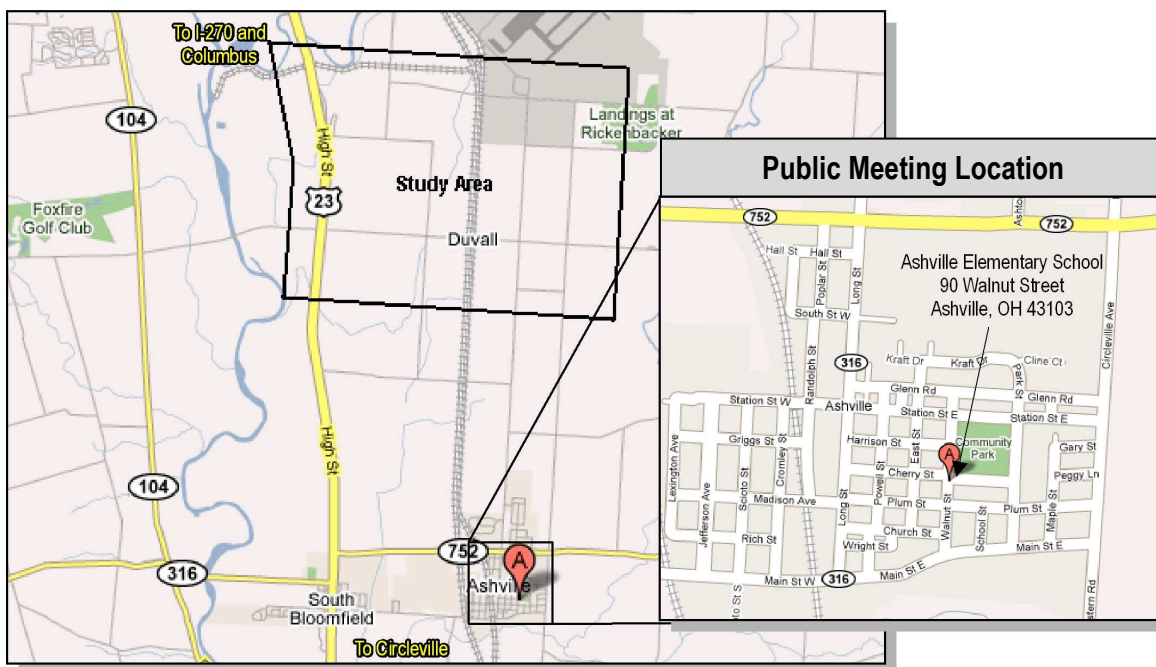


Pickaway East-West Connector Public Meeting Invite

The Pickaway County Engineer's Office and Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission (MORPC) encourages the public to attend a public meeting for the Pickaway East-West Connector project. The proposed project is studying potential connections between Rickenbacker International Airport and US 23 in northern Pickaway County. The area under study is bound roughly by the Franklin/Pickaway County line (north), approximately 3,000 feet east of Lockbourne-Eastern Road (east), approximately 4,000 feet south of Duvall Road (south), and approximately 2,000 feet west of US 23 (west). The meeting will be held **Thursday, March 19, 2009 from 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. at Ashville Elementary School at 90 Walnut Street, Ashville, Ohio 43103**. The meeting will be in an "open house" style and no formal presentations will be made. You may visit at any time to view the project materials and ask questions.



The purpose of the meeting is to inform the public about the project, and encouraged them to comment and ask questions. Maps of the Conceptual Alternative Solutions ("Concepts"), a matrix that compares the Concepts, and other pertinent information, including previous project documents, will be available for public inspection. During the hearing the public will be able to discuss the project in an informal manner with Pickaway County and ODOT officials along with representation from TranSystems Corp., who is conducting the study. Public comments received during and following the meeting will be considered when making future project related decisions.
